- Topical herbal formulas and protocol

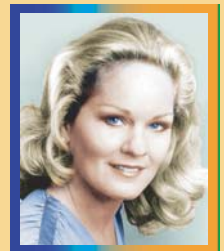

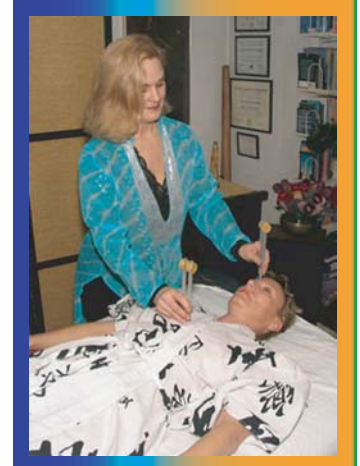
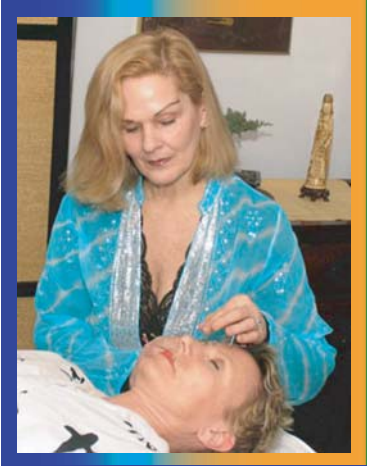
